Daniël Kruger was born in 1951 in South Africa and currently lives in Germany, where he is head of the jewellery Department at the University for Art and design, in Halle. He studied under Professor Hermann Jünger at the Academy of Fine Arts in Munchen. Since 1980 galleries and museums exhibited his work worldwide, for instance in 's Hertogenbosch, Pforzheim, Tokyo, Vienna, Amsterdam (galerie Ra), and Philadelphia. He lectured around the world about his work in jewelry and ceramics (for instance in the European Ceramic work centre in 's Hertogenbosch.) in London; Providence & Boston in the USA.

In Pforzheim; Tokyo; and Amsterdam, at the Gerrit Rietveld Akademie and Het Sandberg Instituut. His work has been recognized internationally with awards and distinctions, and can be seen in renowned public collections, such as the Jewellery Museum in Pforzheim; the Hiko Mizuno College of Jewellery in Tokyo; the Stedelijk Museum 's Hertogenbosch; and the Power House Museum in Sydney.
